Membership process

- Form is received by NSS Administration, checked and approved by CEO (authority delegated by board)
- Membership fee (if received with application) is receipted and banked
- NSS Administration enters the details and approval date for each new member into the NSS Membership Register
- Welcome letter and electronic copy of annual report emailed to approved members within 10 working days of entering on the NSS Membership Register (for members without email address the letter will be posted).
- Welcome letter may include membership fee invoice for new members who have not paid fee with their application

Membership renewal process

- Renewal letters are sent to members in August of each year
- Membership renewals to be finalised no later than 35 days before the Annual General Meeting (usually held in the last week of November)
